Work Shift Preference

MMM runs on volunteers who do 2 hour work shifts in any of several functions/ areas that help get all the work done. *All those attending who are over 12 years old are expected to work a shift unless specifically exempted by the Second Officer.*
Please check the ONE area in which you would most prefer to volunteer. Area coordinators may contact you before the event to schedule your shift and inform you about any training opportunities.

Waiver and Release

I understand that Magical Mountain Mabon is an outdoor camping experience held in a remote, wooded area, with all the hazards associated with such a location, including but not limited to, risk of physical injury, lack of sanitation, etc. I understand that it is my responsibility to be adequately prepared for any eventuality in terms of camping equipment, clothing, food, etc. I am, at all times, fully responsible for the safety of myself and any minor children in my care. In the event I, or any minor children in my care, are injured, I hereby give permission for volunteers to render first aid in accordance with their judgment and training and agree to hold them harmless for any assistance rendered in my behalf, or in behalf of any minor children in my care. I also hold harmless the Chamisa Local Council of the Covenant of the Goddess (CLC), its officers, members, and affiliates from any or all injury or other damages I may incur during Magical Mountain Mabon. I assume full responsibility, financial, legal and otherwise, for myself, any minor children in my care, and any animals in my custody. I agree to abide by the rules and bylaws of the CLC, rules specific to Magical Mountain Mabon, and by any decisions of a Council of Elders convened by the CLC First or Second Officer to decide questions of behavior or safety.
